Mayor Williams provided City Council members with information regarding the Local Government Review laws and process in the state of Montana. Per state law, the question of whether to conduct this study must be put on the ballot this year for city residents to vote on.

New Business:

Councilmember Dudley moved to approve Resolution No. 2024-02 authorizing the donation of a 2016 Dodge RAM vehicle to the Rosebud County Search and Rescue. Councilmember Koczur seconded the motion.

Discussion: City Council members expressed their desire that the vehicle be kept in Colstrip. Public Comment: Todd Olmstead addressed the City Council regarding the organization and the need for the vehicle. He expressed his appreciation for the donation of the vehicle. Councilmember Hanser moved to approve the first reading of Ordinance No. 2024-01, prohibiting marijuana businesses within city limits based on the results of the 11/7/23 ballot question. Councilmember Rosander seconded the motion.

Discussion: Councilmember Hanser noted this ordinance is based on the majority of voters in Colstrip not wanting to have this type of business in town.
